The Minibus Service to Ely run twice monthly by the Parish Council in partnership with Dial-a-Ride is set to improve. New times, effective from April, will extend the time in Ely to 3 hours on one of the trips each month while the second will remain at 2 hours.

A drop-off and pick-up point at the new Sainsburys store and also Ely Market is to be introduced also.

The minibus service is open to everyone in the village and costs just £5 return (£2.50 with bus pass). It runs on the first and third Thursdays of each month. To book a place or for more information call Dial-a-Ride on 01353 661161.

### SKATEBOARD PARK

Burwell Parish Council provide and maintain a number of play grounds, open spaces and areas around the village including a skateboard/BMX park at the Recreation Park off Hythe Lane.

We encourage users of skateboards, bikes and foot-operated scooters to hone their skill at the park.

Unfortunately in recent weeks the skateboard ramps have been subject to vandalism and so a ramp has been temporarily unusable. Repairs to which have been effected by the Parish Council at its expense and the ramp is now available for use.



The park is used by residents of all ages and we hope that such acts of vandalism are a one-off allowing all our open spaces to be freely enjoyed by everyone throughout the year.
