BURWELL VISION

Residents of Burwell have just a few weeks left to make their views known on the Burwell Vision, the document that will be included in the East Cambridgeshire District Local Plan outlining future developments in the area.

The Vision should follow the guidelines that have been set out in the Masterplan which has been consulted on over the past two years and is now formally accepted by the District Council. If anyone has not yet seen the details of the Burwell Vision, please go along to the library, or the Parish Council Office for more details or look on line at: www.eastcambs.gov.uk.

There will be a final drop-in information session at the **Gardiner Memorial Hall** on **Saturday 23rd March 9.30am - 1.30pm**. Council officers will be on hand to answer any questions and opinion forms will be available on the day. Final day for the consultation forms to arrive at East Cambridgeshire District Council is Monday 25th March.





VILLAGE SIGN

Several people have asked why the village sign has not yet been put back up. The sign has now been totally restored and is being stored until the bad weather has passed. It will then be reinstated on a new post in its original position on Pound Hill.

MINIBUS SERVICE TO ELY

The Minibus Service to Ely run twice monthly by the Parish Council in partnership with Dial-a-Ride is set to improve. In the coming months there are plans to extend the time in Ely to 3 hours on one of the trips each month while the second trip will remain at 2 hours. There is likely to be a drop-off and pick-up point at the new Sainsburys store and also Ely Market.

The minibus service is open to everyone in the village and costs just £5 return (£2.50 with bus pass). It runs on the first and third Thursdays of each month. To book a place or for more information call Dial-a-Ride on 01353 661161.
