ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN AND VICE CHAIRMAN

The Annual Parish Council Meeting took place on Tuesday, 27th May during which elections for Chairman and Vice Chairman took place.

Derek Reader was re-elected as the Parish Council Chairman and Joan Lonsdale was re-elected as Vice Chairman.

BURWELL & DISTRICT DAY CENTRE

Following a complaint from a neighbour of the Burwell and District Day Centre, concerning noise and odour from a newly installed extraction and ventilation system, an Abatement Notice has been served on the Parish Council who are leaseholders of the property.

The Day Centre is operational with staff having adapted working practices to deal with the unavailability of the equipment. The Day Centre continues to provide a full service of meals and entertainment The Parish Council is currently liaising with the Environmental Officer and the suppliers of the equipment to seek a resolution of the issue by the 22nd of July.

GARDINER MEMORIAL HALL WORKS



Burwell Parish council have agreed in principle to a major programme of external work to Gardiner Memorial Hall. Little has been carried out in recent years and it is planned that the works will be completed this year, preferably by the autumn.

This is the first phase of work anticipated on the Hall over the coming years. The external maintenance programme

will be funded from earmarked and general reserves. It is planned that the Hall will remain in use whilst the work takes place.

BURWELL TO EXNING CYCLE PATH

Exning Parish Council have approached Burwell Parish Council to gain their views on the provision of a cycle path between Exning and Burwell. Burwell Parish Council are very supportive of the idea. A working group is to be established. Cllr. David Brown identified that the cycle path was in the Cambridgeshire Mid to Long Term Plan. He recommended that Suffolk County Council be involved.



PARKING

Complaints have been received from residents of Pound Close about inconsiderate and long-term parking. Whist parking on Pound Close and surrounding roads is not illegal; we ask that people are thoughtful when using the area.

when nominated: he or she is a British Subject or citizen of the European Union or Ireland, has attained 18 years of age, and is either: on the register of electors for that Parish/Town, or has during the whole of the preceding twelve months:- occupied land as owner or tenant, had a principal place of work there, or resided in or within 4.8 kilometres (three miles) of it.
