# **BLUE PLAQUE UNVEILING IN BURWELL**

Local residents, visitors and distinguished guests gathered at Mitchams Agricultural Machinery Ltd, The Old Stables, Berkeley House, Burwell on the afternoon of Sunday the 22nd of February to celebrate the unveiling of a blue plaque to honour the work of Marjory Stephenson.

Marjory Stephenson, MBE, (1885 – 1948), who was born and grew up in Burwell, was a British biochemist. In 1945, she was one of the first two women elected a Fellow of the Royal Society. Marjory produced, as author or co-author, more than twenty papers. She is most widely remembered for her seminal book, Bacterial Metabolism, which was the standard work on the subject for generations of microbiologists and biochemists

Local MP Sir James Paice and Vice President of the Society of Biology, Sir John Skehel unveiled the plaque marking the home of Marjory. Parish Councillor Pat Kilbey gave the welcome speech on behalf of Parish Council and the Historical Plaque Committee.

# **IMPORTANT NOTICE - CEMETERY**

During May 2015 the Parish Council will be undertaking extensive turfing and selective re-seeding of graves at the cemetery in Ness Road with particular focus on the graves in Section G. In order to be able to carry out this work the Parish Council needs to ask for your co-operation. If you look after the grave of a loved one who is buried in Section G (the area currently being used) please can you remove all items from the grave area other than the memorial stone placed at the head of the grave. Any item not removed by the 30th April 2015 will need to be removed by the Parish Council and will be retained for collection. If you know of anyone else who tends a grave that may not have seen this notice, please could you make them aware of this request?

Once the turf is laid, please can we ask that our regulations, which are available on the notice board at the Cemetery, on the parish council website www.burwellparishcouncil.gov.uk or from the Jubilee Reading Room are adhered to.
