IMPORTANT NOTICE - CEMETERY

During May 2015 the Parish Council will be undertaking extensive turfing and selective reseeding of graves at the cemetery in Ness Road with particular focus on the graves in Section G. In order to be able to carry out this work the Parish Council needs to ask for your co-operation.

If you look after the grave of a loved one who is buried in Section G (the area currently being used) please can you remove all items from the grave area other than the memorial stone placed at the head of the grave? Any item not removed by the **30th April 2015** will need to be removed by the Parish Council
